As a result of her disease (severe epilepsy), **JESSICA** is physical and mental handicapped. Jessica can move only supervised, as she does not notice hindrances on the way and her reaction ability is not gear enough. She cannot speak or show, what she wants, and does not understand a lot.

These are the reasons for spending the days with her mother at home or in various therapies (logo-, hippo-, physiotherapy, osteopathy). All these therapies bring about a slowly but clear recovery of her situation. Sometimes she plays with another children at the playground – at best she gets along with two year old children ... Her mother says, Jessica is – although her poor destiny – a sunny child: „She wakes up in the morning and laughs.“ Her cry, means her mum, is a clear sign, that the girl feels very bad.

Since one year, Jessica has attended the hippotherapy regularly once a week. A short time ago, Jessica could sit alone on the horse for the very first time! She really loves riding and – what's important – it affects her attitude very positive (further the girl could hardly hold her head alone and could sit only extreme ducked – today her spine is straight and her head "dangles" only rarely). That's why her biggest wish is to have the possibility to attend a second unit of hippotherapy a week – half year long.

By performance her heart's desire you allow for more progress and joy in Jessica's life. Sincere thanks are given to you for that!
